Black Hawk - Milling and resurfacing on US 63 in Waterloo will cause lane closures and intersection restrictions between Mulberry and Arlington Streets starting on Monday, July 26th. Flaggers will direct traffic through intersections affected by the milling and/or paving. "Drivers can expect a longer closure at the Franklin Street intersection. Barricades at Franklin Street and Broadway will restrict through traffic at the Franklin Street intersection." Through traffic on US 63 should only see minor delays. Work should be completed in a week.

The Iowa DOT reminds motorists to drive with caution, obey posted speed limits and other signs in the work area and be aware that traffic fines for moving violations are at least double in work zones. As in all work zones, drivers should stay alert, allow ample space between vehicles and wear seat belts.
